Subj: request to modify the way that we provide usenet news services

The TSC would like to change the way that we provide Usenet News Services. We currently run our news server 'in house' with a news feed from a third party. When we originally established the news service, there were few other options. With the expansion of the internet, however, many other options now exist. We propose to move our entire usenet news service to a News Service Provider. The benefits of this change will be:

- * Expanded group selection - the external server will offer a wider selection of newsgroups (including regional hierarchies from around the country) than we can currently offer with our current news feed.
- * Improved Internet access - by eliminating the network traffic caused by the incoming news feed (6GB/day!), access times to sites outside IUP will be improved.
- * Enhanced e-mail performance - the system currently used to run our news server can be redeployed to provide improved e-mail IMAP services.

IUP Usenet news users would not need to re-configure their Client programs. They would, however, need to reset their "seen" articles when we move to the new server resulting in a minor, one time inconvenience.

While the proposed change will result in this one time need for usenet news users to reset their "seen" articles, we believe that the benefits exceed this one time inconvenience. By using a Usenet News Server Service Provider, we can offer everything we offer today and more -- with virtually no increase in costs plus all of the benefits noted above.

We hope to implement this service July 99. Please advise as soon as possible with any concerns. thanks
