The IUP String Project is now accepting applications for the Fall 2024 semester. The IUP String Project is a program that provides string students in the Indiana area with an opportunity to take private lessons on violin, viola, cello and bass after school. The IUP String Project is designed to support and enhance the string programs already in the schools. The teachers are string majors and minors from the IUP Music Department who are studying to be string teachers. As part of the teacher training program, IUP students receive pedagogical training and supervision from the IUP String Area faculty members.

The String Project will begin the school year on **Thursday, September 12** with an **Open House** for parents and students **at 6:30 pm in Cogswell Hall, Room 201**. The Open House will provide a short, informal recital by String Project teachers and students, information for the year, and time to meet with your teacher and set up a weekly lesson time. Parents and students are encouraged to attend this meeting. For those unable to attend, teachers will contact you to set up a lesson time and provide the information packet at the first lesson. Each student will receive 11 weekly individual lessons during the semester. Lessons will commence the week of **September 15** and conclude with a recital on the morning of **Saturday, December 7 at 10:30 a.m.** in Gorell Hall at IUP. Your teacher will work with you to find a time that is mutually agreeable.

This semester the String Project will once again offer ensemble classes at the end of the semester free of charge. These fun, interactive sessions provide students with a wonderful opportunity to work with other students at similar age and ability level.
