## Remember....

- x The employer shall ensure that each powered industrial truck operator is trained andcompetent to operate a powered industrial truck safely
- x Training consists of:
  - Formal instruction (e.g., lecture, discussion, interactive computer learning, written material),
  - Practical training (demonstrations and exercises performed by the trainee), and
  - o , and
  - o Site specific hazards

- x Neveroverloadthe PIT. Refer to the capacity plate on the truck if unsure
- x Neverattempt to operate a PIT for which you have not been trained
- x Always wear you seat belt
- x Lower the forks and set the parking brake when the truck is left unattended
- x Keep the forks as low to the ground as possible when operating the PIT
- x Always drive straighup and straight down inclines
- x Conductpre-shift inspections of the PIT. If this inspection identifies a potential hazard do not operate, and notify your supervisor.
