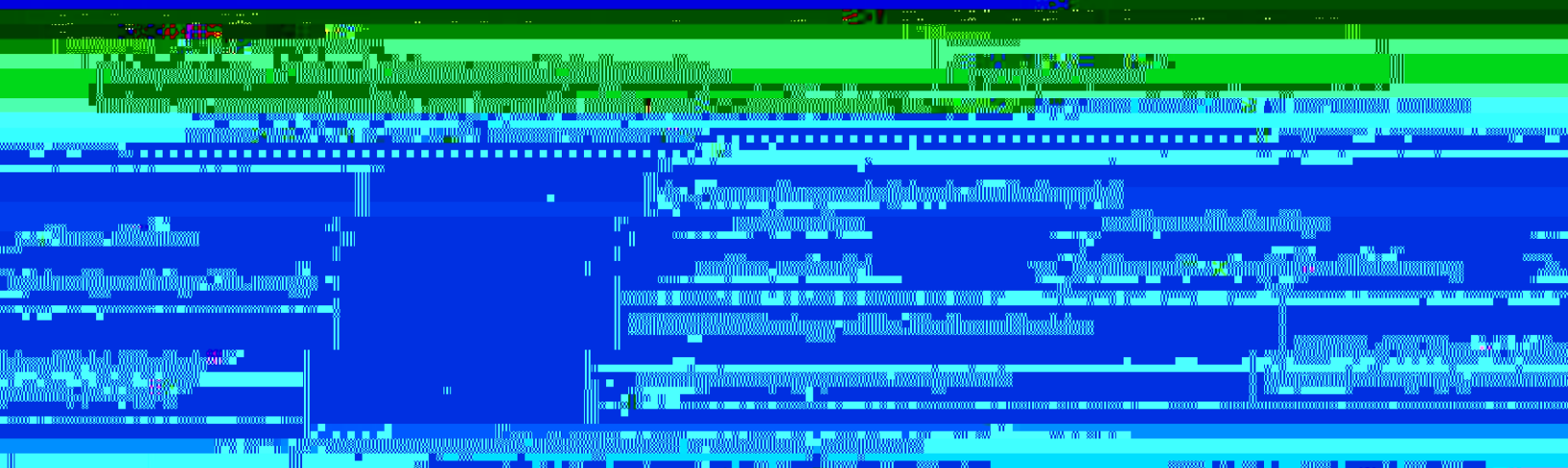

Part II. Description of Curriculum Change

1. Catalog Description

GEOS 402 Northern Rockies Field Workshop

(var-3cr)

Prerequisite: GEOS 401; instructor permission required

A field study of the major geologic features and relationships involved in the development of the northern Rocky Mountains. National Park and Monument areas of South Dakota, Wyoming and Montana are included among the areas investigated. (Three weeks, taught in the summer only).

2. Proposed Changes

Old Catalog Description:

Prerequisite: Instructor permission required, at least 14cr of Geoscience courses recommended

A field study of the major geologic features and relationships involved in the development of the northern Rocky Mountains. National Park and Monument areas of South Dakota, Wyoming and Montana are included among the areas investigated. (Three weeks, taught in the summer only).

Proposed changes include a) a change in course number, b) elimination of the requirement that a student have completed 14 credits of Geoscience coursework, and c) addition of GEOS 401 as a prerequisite

3. Justification/Rationale for Proposed Changes

a) The change in course number is proposed to be consistent with the Geoscience Department's
