

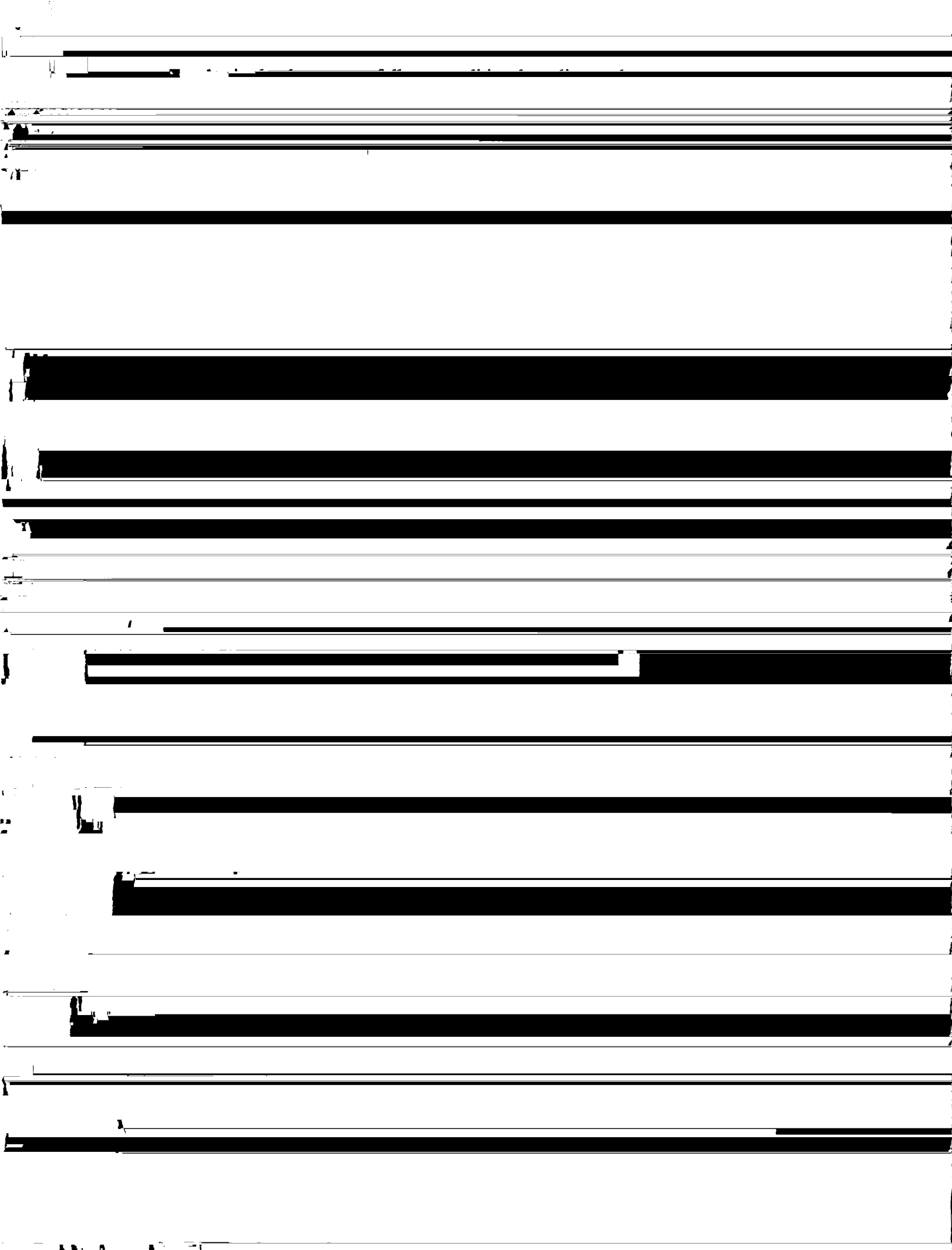

I. Catalogue Description

NU 480 Seminar in Nursing 1c-0l-1c

Prerequisites: NU 280, NU 285

A seminar which provides a forum for the exploration and discussion of issues relevant to the professional nurse. Emphasis is placed on the development of professional values, critical thinking, decision-making, and communication skills. A selection of topics on current issues and trends will be offered each semester; each will focus on a particular theme related to nursing practice. One credit hour of

Section A: Details of the Course

- A1 This course will be required for students in the Nursing major. Students will be required to take four sections of the course--one each semester--in the Upper Division years of study.
- A2 Implementation of this course requires deletion of NU 300, 310, 400, and 410. The intent of these four seminar courses has been incorporated into this one course. No other changes in the content of existing courses or requirements will be necessary.
- A3 The seminar format course has been offered to Nursing Majors in NU 300, 310, 400, and 410. The variety of topic sections format is also not new to the IUP campus, i.e. AN 480, CO 480, CR 480, EN 480.
