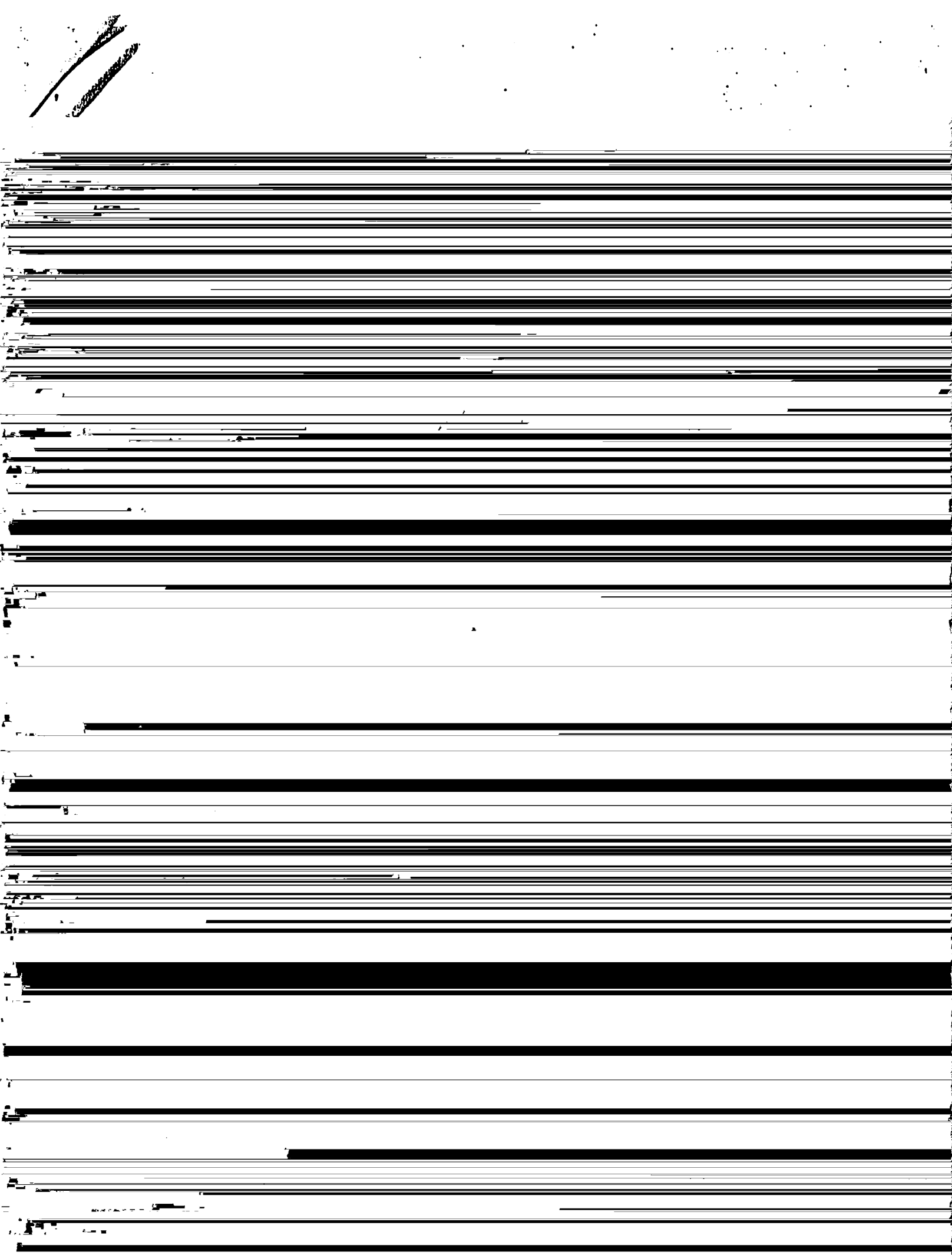

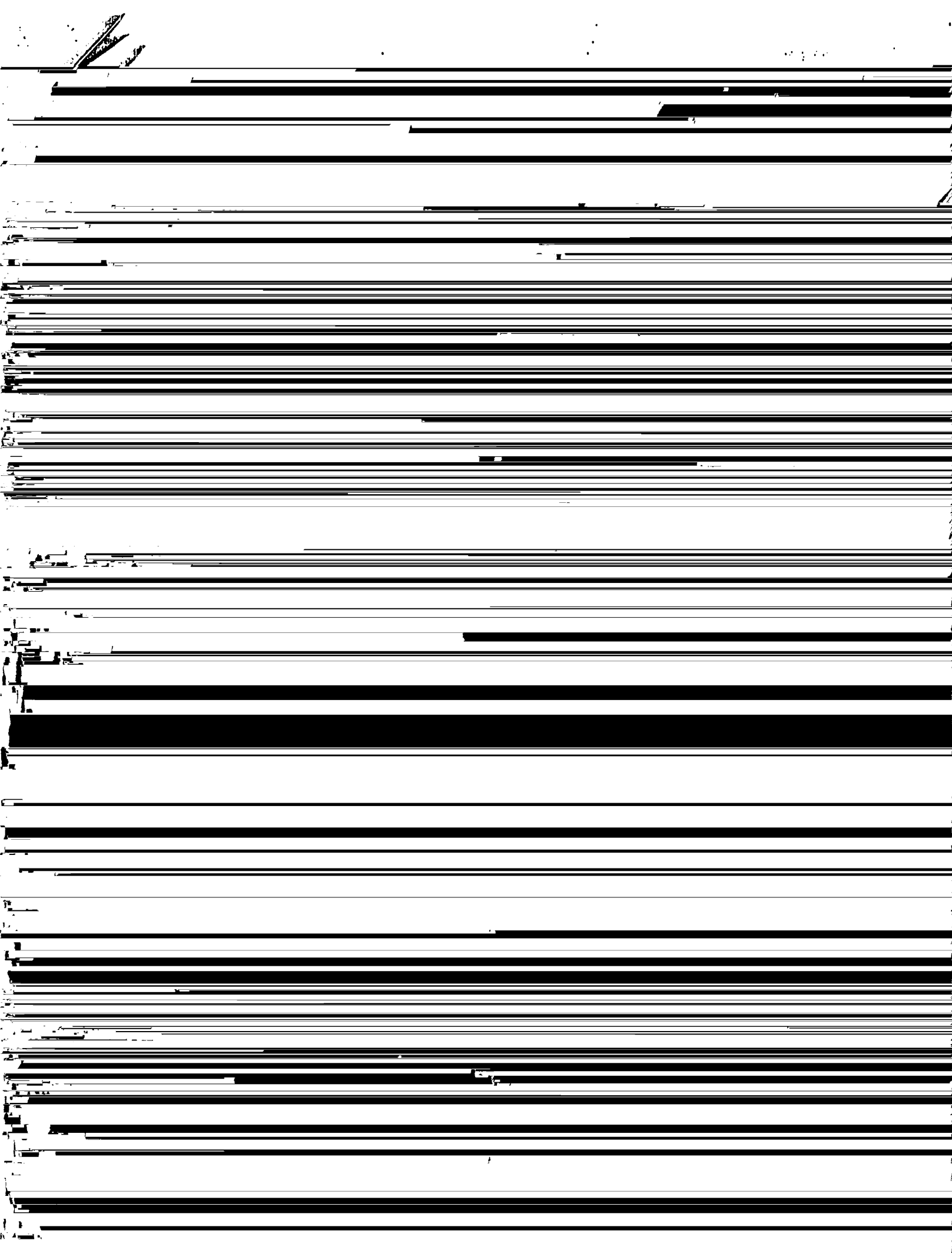

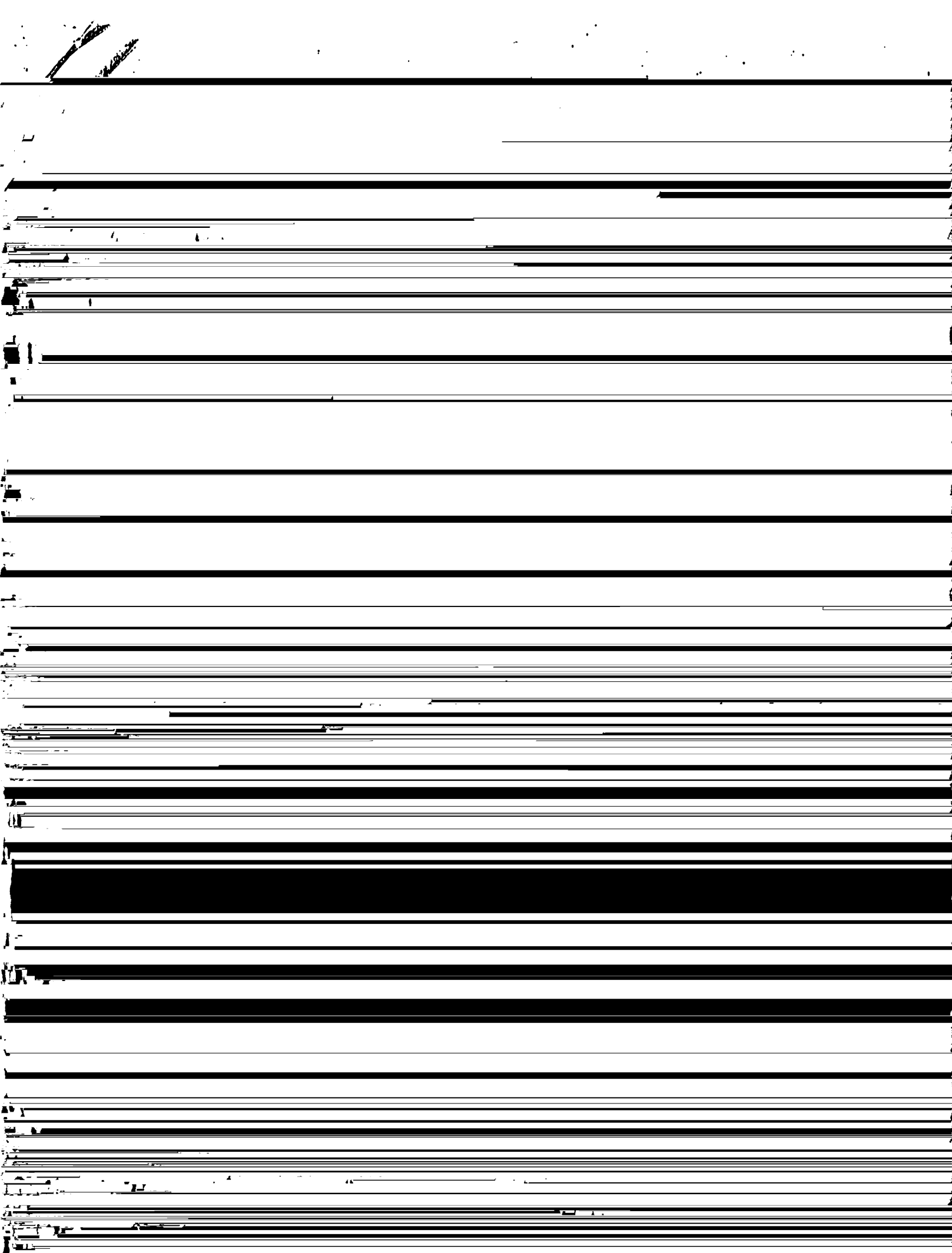


3. RATIONALE FOR CHANGES:

Change i. Rather than allowing a choice between PH 101 Informal Logic: Methods of Critical Thinking and PH 221 Symbolic Logic I, the new PH/Pre-Law major will require PH 101. --Rationale: The faculty member who conducts the LSAT logic workshops maintains that PH 101 is better preparation for the LSAT

Change ii. Rather than requiring PH 324, 325, 420 and 421, the new programs require students to take either 304 or 305 and either 420 or 421

Change iii. PH and PH/Pre-Law majors will be restricted to no more than four (rather than to no more than three) 100-200 level courses. PH minors will continue to be restricted to no more than three 100-200 level courses. —
At present our majors and minors can count no more than three 100-
