

Course Deletion: SAFE 301 Health Hazard Recognition

Part II. Description of the Curriculum Change

1. SAFE 301 Health Hazard Recognition is being deleted from the Safety Sciences B.S. Curriculum.
2. Justification/rationale: With the 2005 revision in the B.S. Program in Safety Sciences there was a change from three industrial hygiene courses (SAFE 301, 303 & 402 - 9 credits) to two industrial hygiene courses with labs (SAFE 320 & 420 - 8 credits). Specifically, the recognition of health hazards was covered in SAFE 301, the control in SAFE 303 and the evaluation in SAFE 402. The three course sequence created
