

1 CDFR prefix changes

Rationale:

2 Criminology Changes

Rationale:

We need to remove courses that are no longer being offered by Criminology in the Juvenile Delinquency

- CRIM 451 (Etiology of Delinquent Behavior) is no longer offered and will be removed, leaving SOC 333 (Delinquency and Youth) as the only required course.


