

1. The Board of Trustees shall have the authority to hire, fire, and reassign any and all employees of the institution, including but not limited to the President, Vice Presidents, and all other full-time and part-time employees, subject to the approval of the Board of Trustees.

2. The Board of Trustees shall have the authority to establish the compensation and benefits for the President, Vice Presidents, and all other full-time and part-time employees of the institution, subject to the approval of the Board of Trustees.

3. The Board of Trustees shall have the authority to establish the policies and procedures for the institution, including but not limited to the policies and procedures for the hiring, firing, and reassignment of employees, the compensation and benefits for employees, and the policies and procedures for the institution's financial operations.

4. The Board of Trustees shall have the authority to establish the policies and procedures for the institution's financial operations, including but not limited to the policies and procedures for the institution's budgeting, financial reporting, and the management of the institution's assets.

5. The Board of Trustees shall have the authority to establish the policies and procedures for the institution's academic operations, including but not limited to the policies and procedures for the institution's curriculum, the admission and retention of students, and the management of the institution's academic affairs.

6. The Board of Trustees shall have the authority to establish the policies and procedures for the institution's student affairs, including but not limited to the policies and procedures for the institution's student government, the management of student organizations, and the management of the institution's student activities.

7. The Board of Trustees shall have the authority to establish the policies and procedures for the institution's community relations, including but not limited to the policies and procedures for the institution's public relations, the management of the institution's community outreach programs, and the management of the institution's relations with the community.

8. The Board of Trustees shall have the authority to establish the policies and procedures for the institution's internal control system, including but not limited to the policies and procedures for the institution's internal auditing, the management of the institution's internal control system, and the management of the institution's risk management.

9. The Board of Trustees shall have the authority to establish the policies and procedures for the institution's information technology system, including but not limited to the policies and procedures for the institution's information technology infrastructure, the management of the institution's information technology system, and the management of the institution's information security.

10. The Board of Trustees shall have the authority to establish the policies and procedures for the institution's legal affairs, including but not limited to the policies and procedures for the institution's legal counsel, the management of the institution's legal affairs, and the management of the institution's compliance with applicable laws and regulations.

Deletion of THTR 208 Modern Theater II, 3c-0l-3cr

Rationale

This course is one of four that cover Western theater history in chronological sequence from its origins to the present day. (THTR 205 Classic Theater I, THTR 206 Classic Theater II, THTR 207 Modern Theater I and THTR 208 Modern Theater II). The current program only requires students to take two out of these four courses (one from the Classical period and one from the Modern period).
